Jesus on the Royal Mile is a celebration of the last journey of Jesus, through the streets of Jerusalem to the Cross. The event begins at the Merkat Cross outside St Giles' at 2.30pm and then continues to Old St Paul's, St Patrick's and Canongate Kirk, before the final act of worship in the grounds of Holyrood Abbey. A cross is carried at the head of the procession and a short service is held in each location.
